Individuals with an established career from academia, government, or the private sector are eligible. Candidates should be at the Associate Professor rank or above if in academia or at an equivalent senior rank in government agencies or industry. Nominees must be SPER members in good standing

To nominate an individual for this award, please submit the following: (i) letter of nomination from an SPER member; (ii) two additional letters from persons who have been or currently are being mentored by the nominee (including but not limited to student advisees, junior faculty or staff, or other persons who are/were mentored by the nominee); and (iii) the nominee's curriculum vitae
